

## **PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

On or about July 2, 2010, the Town of New Carlisle intends to apply to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs for a grant from the Office of Community and Rural Affairs CDBG Disaster Recovery Appropriation. This program is funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. These funds are to be used for community disaster assistance. The total amount of Disaster Recovery funds to be requested is \$88,000. The amount of Disaster Recovery funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low- and moderate-income persons is \$64,002. The Applicant also proposes to expend an estimated \$16,000 in non-CDBG funds on the project. These non-CDBG funds will be derived from the following sources: Town of New Carlisle's Local Road and Street fund in the amount of \$5,000, and Town of New Carlisle's Motor Vehicle and Highway fund in the amount of \$11,000.

**The Town of New Carlisle will hold a public hearing on July 1, 2010, at 9:00 a.m., in Town Hall**, 124 East Michigan Street, New Carlisle, to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federally funded CDBG Disaster Recovery project. Every effort will be made to make reasonable accommodations for these persons.
